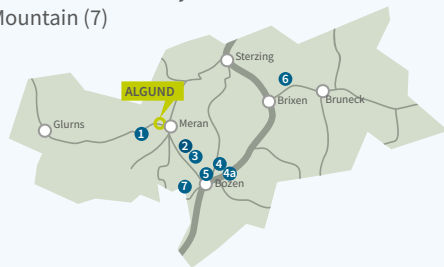


» Museums

The Südtirol GuestPass Algend grants one free admission to each museum listed in this leaflet. Please consult the museum or the local tourist office for updated opening hours. No extra services such as guided tours, museum educational activities or special events are included, unless explicitly indicated. When visiting a museum, it is necessary to present the Südtirol GuestPass Algend.

» Cable cars

- The cable cars to **Aschbach/Rio Lagundo (1)**, Burgstall/Postal-Vöran/Verano (2), Vilpian/Vilpiano-Mölten/Meltina (3), Bozen/Bolzano-Ritten/Renon (4), Bozen/Bolzano-Kohlern/Colle (5) and Mühlbach/Rio di Pusteria - Meransen/Maranza (6)
- Use of the narrow-gauge railway in Ritten/Renon (4a) and the cable railway to the Mendel Mountain (7)

Use public transportation, experience South Tyrolean history with a museum visit, or participate in special events and workshops in Algend, all at no extra cost!

» How to use the Südtirol GuestPass Algend

The card is valid for the entire duration of your stay, cannot be purchased, and is only available through one of the partner accommodations in Algend. For stays longer than a week, you are entitled to a second card. To ensure the Südtirol GuestPass Algend is valid, please fill in the holder's name and the dates of the stay. It is important to validate the card for each journey on public transportation or when visiting museums. For participation in workshops and events in Algend, you need to present the card.

Children under 6 years old traveling with an adult do not need their own card. Please note that an additional ticket is required for bicycles, dogs, and other animals! Muzzles are mandatory for dogs.
