No extra services such as guided tours, museum educational activities or special events are included, unless explicitly indicated. When visiting a museum, it is necessary to present the Südtirol GuestPass Algend.

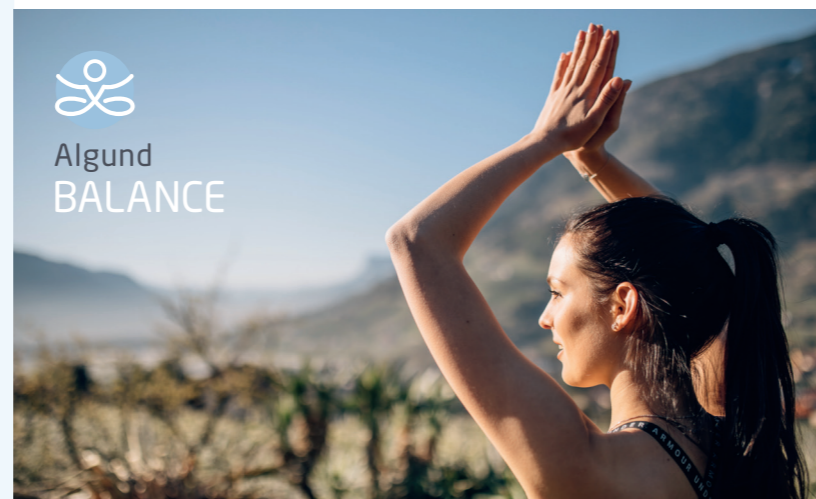

The Südtirol GuestPass Algend is a very special welcome gift from your hosts in Algend! From the moment of check-in, it gives you the opportunity to enjoy a relaxed and car-free holiday. Use all public transports free of charge and explore the whole South Tyrol in an environmentally conscious manner. With this pass, you can also visit over 80 museums and participate in special events and workshops in Algend (see the list). Your stay will become a sustainable and delightful experience.

» How to use the Südtirol GuestPass Algend

All guests staying at a partner accommodation in Algend get their own card. The card is valid for the entire stay and not available for purchase. Should you stay for longer than one week, you are entitled to a second card. To ensure the Südtirol GuestPass Algend is as a valid ticket, please fill in the holder's name and the dates of the stay. It is important to validate the card for each journey on public transportation or when visiting museums. For participation in workshops and events in Algend (refer to the list), you need to present the card.

Children under the age of 6, accompanied by an adult holding the Südtirol GuestPass Algend, do not require a card of their own. Please note that an additional ticket is required for bicycles, dogs, and other animals! Muzzles are mandatory for dogs.

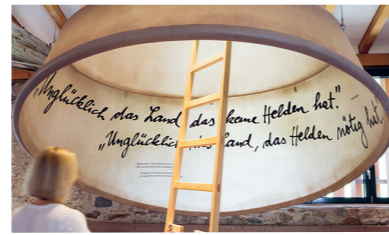

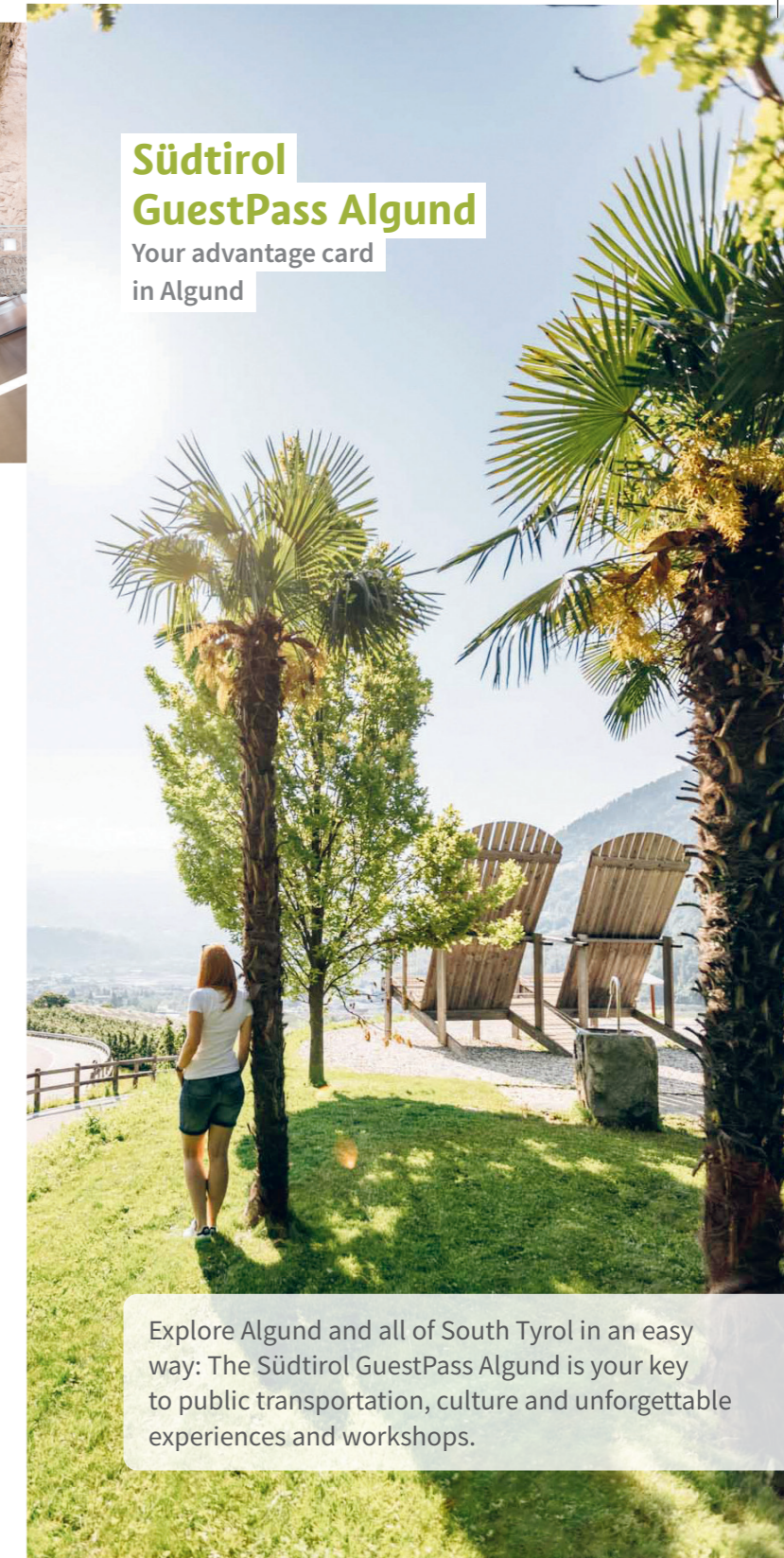
